

KEYPORT IMPROVEMENT CLUB

April 10, 2018 Meeting MINUTES

Welcome and Introductions – Gene Warden called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm.

SPECIAL GUEST SPEAKER – Rob Gelder, Kitsap County Commissioner and Keyport resident addressing topics important to Keyport.

Stormwater improvements for the south side of Washington Blvd. by the church will occur this fall. The sewer spill at Naval Base Kitsap has been found and the repair should be completed by the end of this week. There are no immediate plans for an additional siphon sewer pipe system under Liberty Bay. Although the Keyport Sewer Strategy Plan has been adopted, expansion to the west side of town is not in the future and depends on desire of those home owners.

No plans to add public transit routes in Keyport. WSDOT will conduct a speed study on Highway 308 into town. Patching and paving for Highway 308 will occur in 2021.
