- **Disaster Preparedness and Ready Relief - Karol Stevens** - Her son-in-law, Chris Hux, has donated several 5 ga. buckets of emergency supplies from the clinic system where he works. The committee will go through them after Thanksgiving and see what we can keep and where to disburse them. There are 3 buckets to a kit and were originally provided for employees in preparation for a shelter type emergency.

The thought is that they may be used through-out our community, perhaps at the businesses.

- **Keyport Fest - Flo Schule** - Requests \$1500.00 for NK Marching Band and the Sea Cadets \$375.

There was a discussion on the decreased amount for the band but due to the Fest profit not being as large this year, it was agreed to go forward with the lesser amount.

**A motion was made by Karol Stevens to go with the Fest recommendation for a reduction in funds and to include Sea Cadets. The motion was unanimously passed.**
