### **General Business:**

**Parks Committee** – Karol reported that Doug is still working with Christine Rolfes to try to mediate the Central Park agreement regarding the installation of an irrigation system.

**Port Of Keyport** – Ellen Ross-Cardoso – The insurance company has denied the claim for the damage that was thought to be from the stolen car that went into the water. Their engineer is looking at it and talking to the company that did the new ramp installation because there is also an issue with one of the support beams that has rotted.

They couldn't reach the deadline for the grant for the purchase of the Posten property and are looking for other sources.

Karol read the letter she wrote for the community support for this project.

**Broadband Fiber Optics Update** – Karol - we're still trying to get a community meeting scheduled to be held by KPUD. It's possible that fliers will need to be distributed door to door to generate participation.

Diane Miller suggested that we need an Instagram page for Keyport to help get the word out.

There is a flier posted at the P.O. for people to review what the project is about.

**Emergency Preparedness Committee** – Karol – Mildew was discovered on a couple of the emergency bags at Central Park so we're looking at a couple of RV desiccants that can be plugged into 120 to dry them out and reuse. They're looking at a solar fan to install in the shed to help with the mildew issue.

New sharpies and batteries are needed for the bags. A motion was made, seconded and approved for up to \$300.00 for these expenses.

The next meeting we'll be looking at our own personal car emergency kits for update.

We encourage everyone in the community to update theirs or purchase one if you don't have one.

The CERT classes that will be offered to the community will be held in the fall. It's about a 30 hr. class that trains volunteers in basic disaster response skills.

**Kitsap County Comprehensive Plan** - Karol read the letter she wrote addressing the community concerns and requests.
