Meeting called to order at 6:34 pm.

April Meeting Minutes Approval – MSP to approve April 9th meeting minutes as presented.

Treasurer’s Report and Treasury Audit Report – This information is available at the KIC meeting or by contacting KIC Treasurer, Flo Schule.

Audit Report due June - Len Marklund volunteered to conduct the audit.

Park Committee - Thank you to the volunteers who helped clean-up Central Park on May 11. Amber Hodgins has volunteered to be main lawn mower.

We have had the approval of the county to move ahead with putting in the watering system. Four bids were received ranging from \$7k-\$14K. It was MSP to take the lowest bid as it is from a landscaper we have done previous business.

Port of Keyport Update – Ellen Ross-Cardoso reported that the State requires a Comprehensive Plan for the Growth Management Act. The commissioners will meet at 9 a.m. on May 21st with a Spring Cleaning at the marina starting at 10 am.

Ellen attended an All-ports meeting. Port of Kingston is donating a Spill Kit to us. Clam Island safety boat has a one-month lease. Watering system reinstalled for flower baskets. A representative from public works will be at June port meeting to update on the new sewer line from Poulsbo that will be replaced sometime this summer.

Broadband FiberOptics – Meeting this **Saturday, May 18** at 10 am with Public Facilities at Keyport Bible Church.

Emergency Preparedness committee – Committee went through the Central Park shed and checked bags. Looking at dehumidifiers to help with the mold. Committee working on getting car kits prepared for each member and will give list of supplies to community so they can prepare their own.

Garden Tour - June 10 We have 8 gardens, glass studio and some other artists participating. Keyport Bible Church youth will have a bake sale. We have flyers and bookmarks printed to advertise. Volunteers are asked to take some to put at businesses. We have had great coverage in WestSound magazine – 2 articles already and a third will be out this summer.

New Business –

Officer Election – Nominations are open for all officer positions. Election will occur at June's meeting.

Home Service Repair List -Need a volunteer for someone to keep up the Home Repair Maintenance recommendation list. Gaye Marklund volunteered. We will send the list out on the community listserv for KIC.

Flower Baskets – Will be planted after coffee tomorrow and hung at the marina and Merc.

KIC Swag - Order forms will be out for Keyport clothing soon. Getting prices from Tuna Graphics for fleece jackets and vests, hoody and t-shirts with the Keyport logo on them.

Other New Business - Central Park needs wood chips around the cedar tree and Fi-Bar chips around the merry-go-round. We will get prices to bring to next meeting. It was suggested that we also look at having a memorial plaque wall for Keyport citizens who have passed. Possibly a section for cement bricks as well for a fundraiser.

Sunday Game Afternoon – We weren't able to hold the May gathering due to staffing issues at the Merc. Future gatherings are postponed until other arrangements can be made.
