General Business

- **Park Committee** Doug Chamberlain
 - Not much to report. Some big stuff has been pulled out. Some big plants have been pulled. It is much more open. Doug will check with the county to see what they have been doing.
- **Port Of Keyport** Ellen Ross Cordosa
 - Waiting to get a price quote on pier repair needs.
 - Earl Hunt is looking into funding for repair
 - Sticking with Port of Brownsville for maintenance
 - 40 boats have been tagged as derelict to be removed from Liberty Bay. (~80 considered derelict in Liberty Bay)
- **Emergency Preparedness Committee** Don Stevens
 - Shed replacement update
 - Moving ahead to do a slab at Ward's house for shed
 - \$750 for concrete company to pour
 - Should be a check from Poulsbo Rotary to help cover
 - Following the first aid class, adding a 4" and 6" Israeli Bandage to each emergency bag
 - Dave Gable is going to install the antenna on the gazebo to extend the reach of MURS radios
 - Currently have 20 people in town with radios
 - Pam and Karol did a walking tour with a tape measure to determine how many houses are impacted. Will be sharing info about that.
